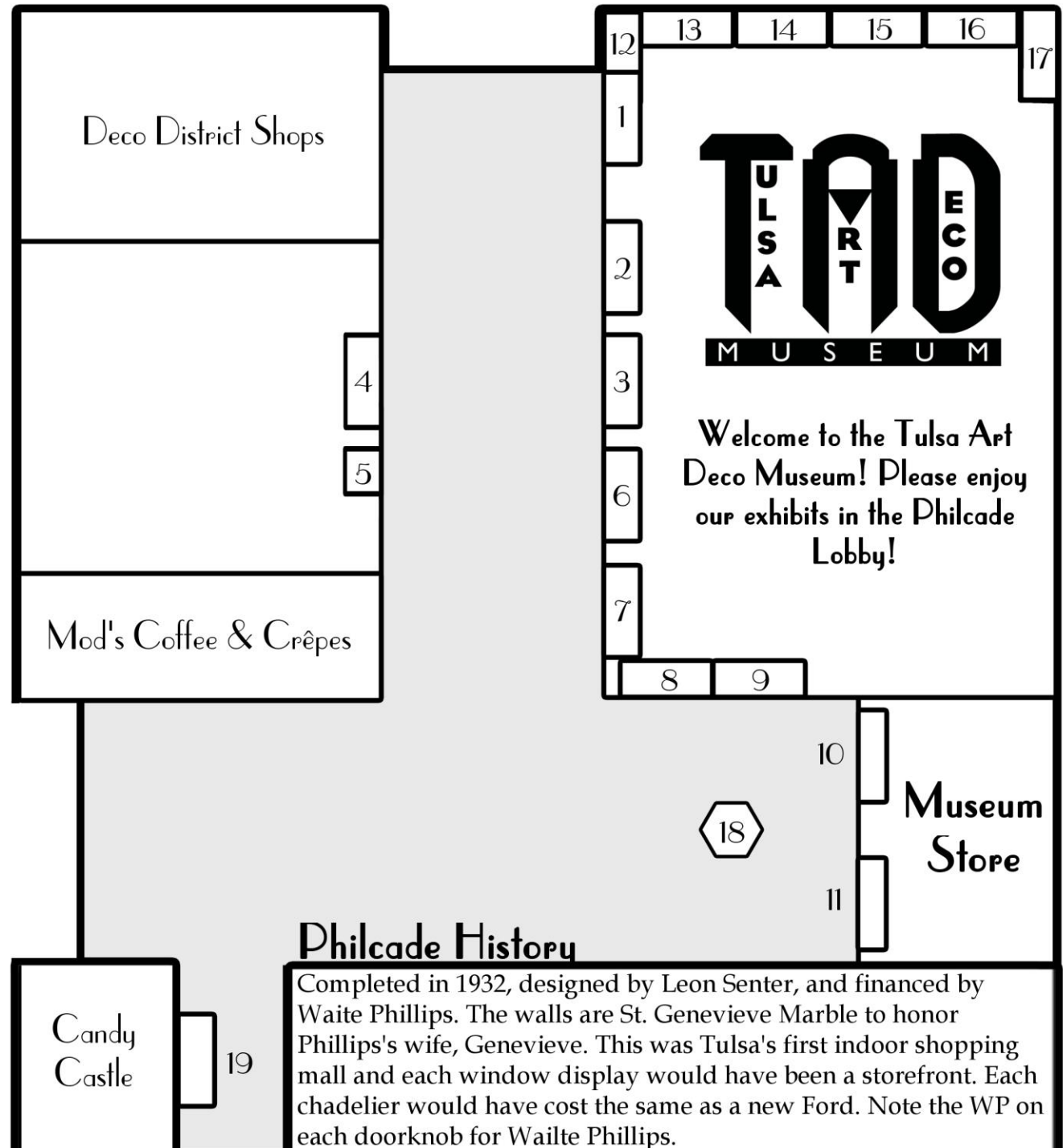

## Philcade History

Completed in 1932, designed by Leon Senter, and financed by Waite Phillips. The walls are St. Genevieve Marble to honor Phillips's wife, Genevieve. This was Tulsa's first indoor shopping mall and each window display would have been a storefront. Each chandelier would have cost the same as a new Ford. Note the WP on each doorknob for Waite Phillips.
